

Pre-Semester Readings Policy

Teaching faculty may assign pre-semester readings for the first day of a class, so that students can start the class with some background knowledge and ready for discussion. However, the quantity of pre-semester reading or preparatory work cannot exceed what is normally assigned for any given week in the semester.

This provision is in place to ensure that students are able to rest and pursue other non-curricular activities during the semester breaks. This provision also exists to ensure that students who enroll in a class close to the start of the semester are not disadvantaged because they had insufficient time to complete the pre-semester readings.
